Reinforcement:

We will strive for a **homerun** classroom! Each student is on our team. When the umpire (me) catches this behavior the batter (students) gets a ticket! When the students fill up the popcorn container we will draw tickets. The students get to pick a reward from the concession stand!

Consequences:

Every game has rules and our classroom does too! Check them out!

Just like baseball our classroom will have a 3 strike policy. If you get **3 strikes** you spend time in the dugout.



Expectations & Rules

○ Safe

Physically AND emotional creating a safe space to learn.

○ Respectful

Respect Authority: teacher, & the **ULTIMATE** authority of God

Show respect to ALL: People, Creation, & Property

○ Responsible

Treat every classmate AND faculty as **beloved** children of God

We will work **TOGETHER** to hold each other accountable for our rules. Together we will define what the three rules **LOOK** and **SOUND** like.

Why & How: Ephesians 6:4 "Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord."

EVERYONE will practice offering **forgiveness** with classroom rules. The Law is used to proclaim the Gospel and not to overwhelm or intimidate students.

Students have the right to a **safe** and **respectful** environment. Our rules are aimed to help give students the guidelines of **HOW** they can do this in the classroom.

The baseball diamond will be posted in the classroom so students have a physical representation of their behavior. It will also have the strike 1, 2, & 3 expectations outlined.
