Reinforcement:

We will strive for a homerun classroom!

Consequences:

Expectations & Rules

O Safe

Physically AND emotional creating a safe space to learn.

Respectful

Respect Authority: teacher, & the ULTIMATE authority of God

Show respect to ALL: People, Creation, & Property

Responsible

Treat every classmate AND faculty as beloved children of God

We will work TOGETHER to hold each other accountable for our rules. Together we will define what the three rules LOOK and SOUND like.

Why & How: Ephesians 6:4 "Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord."

EVERYONE will practice offering forgiveness with classroom rules. The Law is used to proclaim the Gospel and not to overwhelm or intimidate students.

Students have the right to a safe and respectful environment. Our rules are aimed to help give students the guidelines of HOW they can do this in the classroom.

The baseball diamond will be posted in the classroom so students have a physical representation of their behavior. It will also have the strike 1, 2, & 3 expectations outlined.
